Keys to your financial future

**Opportunity Passport™ helps young adults transitioning from foster care to become financially capable by:**

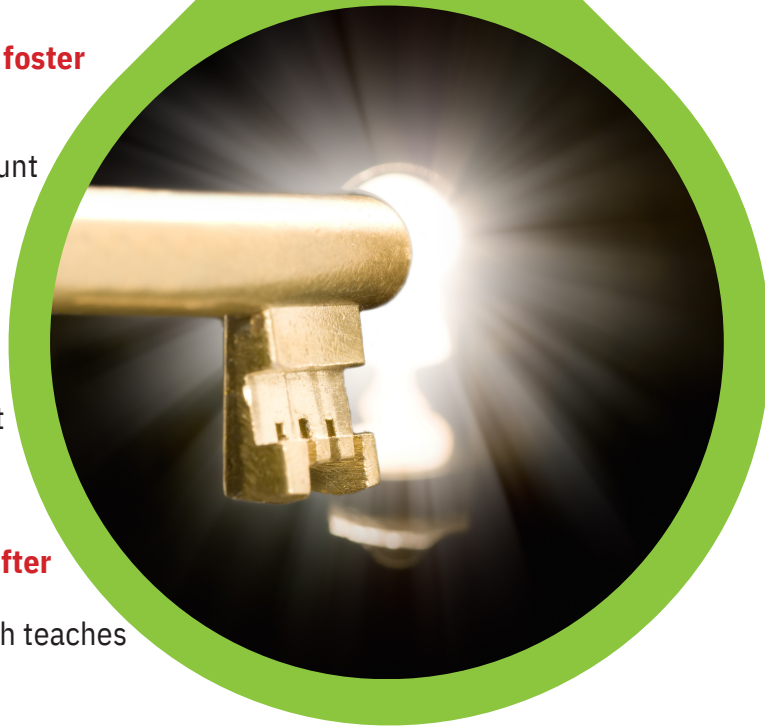
- Teaching money management
- Assisting participants in opening a savings or checking account in their name
- Matching participant savings to purchase an approved asset that will help them transition successfully to adulthood

**Opportunity Passport™ Eligibility Requirements are:**

- Young adults who are between age 14 up to age 26
- Are or were in the foster care system, for at least one day, at age 14 or older
- Resides in Georgia

**A young person becomes enrolled in Opportunity Passport™ after they:**

- Complete the Keys to Your Financial Future curriculum which teaches asset building, good credit and money management.
- Take the baseline Opportunity Passport™ Participant Survey



## Opportunity Passport Quick Facts

*Opportunity Passport is an ASSET matching financial literacy program for GA youth 14-26 years.*

*\*Examples of an ASSET: Home, Car (& Related Expenses), Micro-Enterprise, Investments*

*Opportunity Passport is NOT an emergency fund. Matching could take up to 7-14 days.*
